2021 CHARDONNAY, PLATT VINEYARD, SONOMA COAST

Mouth-watering watermelon, lemon rind and sea spray elements are complemented by profound acidity and a long finish.

PLATT VINEYARD, located in the western hills near Sebastopol, boasts 31 acres situated 5 miles from the Pacific coastline. Elevations range from 425-800 feet, and the climate is relatively cool. Vines are planted southwestern facing on sandy Goldridge loam soils.

THE 2021 VINTAGE was mercifully uneventful - a welcome change! A warm but moderate growing season led to cool, even temps during harvest, allowing us great tannin ripeness at low alcohol. A lighter crop provided bright acid and vibrant perfume, giving us what we feel is a classic vintage.
